WHERE TO APPLY?

- If you are a Wisconsin resident or a nonresident, you may apply for a marriage license in any Wisconsin county.
- The Officiant, wedding date and location must be finalized when applying for a marriage license.
- You may apply 4 days before the wedding date but no earlier than 60 days before (referred to as "Waiting Period").
- All documents must be presented, and fees paid at the time the marriage application is made.

INFORMATION GUIDE

Marriageable Age: Any person who has attained the age of 18 years may marry. If a person is 16 or 17 years old, the license will be issued only with the written consent of parents, guardian, or custodian. No waiver of the 3-day waiting period will be issued. Consent forms are available in the Brown County Clerk's Office.

Birth Certificate: Hospital birth certificates and State Notification of Birth are not acceptable documents. An applicant provided State Certified birth certificate must have a raised official seal.

Social Security Card: A Social Security Card must be presented to Brown County Clerk's Office staff by the applicant (if a Social Security Card has been issued).

Photo Identification: Each applicant is required to provide Photo Identification.

In/Out of State Residents: An application may be completed in any Wisconsin county by both in-state or out of state residents.

Previous Marriage(s): Applicants must present a Death Certificate, State Annulment, or *Finding* of *Facts and Conclusions of Law* of the Final Divorce Judgement from their most recent marriage. Final divorce judgments require a judge's signature and date. Divorced person(s) may not remarry until 6 months after the granting of the Judgment of Divorce regardless of where the action took place. **License Application & Expiration:** The license is valid for 60 days from the issue date. The marriage must take place within this period of time. If not, a new license must be obtained, and fees are collected again.

Waiting Period: Apply a minimum of four (4) days prior to the day of the wedding. The license becomes effective on the 4th day following both parties signing the application. Waiver of the 3day waiting period may be granted; however, a \$25 waiver fee shall be charged. (Waiting period does not include the day the marriage application is signed and the day of the wedding).

Ceremony Officiants: Couples shall make their own wedding arrangements. An accredited ordained minister, priest, judge, or other person qualified to be an *"Officiant"* may perform the ceremony (per WI. State stat. § 765.16).

Officiants must be 18 years of age or older.

Neither the Wisconsin Vital Records Office nor does the Brown County Clerk's Office provide confirmation of the legality of a religious officiant.

Should you question the legality of the officiant of which you have chosen, you may want to seek legal counsel.

Marrying Parties: Both applicants must sign the marriage license application in the presence of the County Clerk's staff.

ALL FEES ARE

Fees: The license application fee is \$125 (cash, local check, debit or credit cards). However, a \$25 waiver fee is charged, if the marriage license needs to be issued a date earlier than the 3-day waiting period. Then, the total amount collected is \$150 – Cash, Debit, or Credit Card Only – NO PERSONAL LOCAL CHECKS ARE ACCEPTED FOR THE WAIVER FEE

If the marriage application must be transported to a healthcare off-site location to obtain a signature, the transportation fee is \$125 and all related fees must be paid in cash, or by debit or credit card. *Please note that fees are nonrefundable.*

Certified Documents from the Register of Deeds: Birth Certificates, Death Certificates and Marriage Certificates may be obtained from the Register of Deeds.
